Vishaniketan iMEET in collaboration with IUCEE organized two days mini symposium on "Problem and Project Based Learning" on 2nd and 3rd December 2022 in online mode.

It was organized in the context of introducing of Problem/Project based Learning (PBL) and encouraging consortium members and others for accelerating the implementation of Problem & Project-based Learning (P2BL) as envisioned in the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The IUCEE has been promoting the P2BL through the Clusters for sharing initiatives and practices among the members. The IUCEE,



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in collaboration with Consortium Members, organized the first Mini-Symposium on the P2BL on 9th and 10th October 2021 in virtual/online mode. Considering the interest in face-to-face interactions and networking, the IUCEE in collaboration with the Project-Based Learning Centre of Excellence of Vishwaniketan, Kumbhivali, Maharashtra, India planned the second Mini-Symposium on P2BL on 2nd (Friday) and 3rd (Saturday), December 2022.

The main objective of the Mini-Symposium is to identify good practices, share the challenges and lessons learned, and prepare an actionable Problem & Project-based Learning (P2BL) roadmap unique to the respective colleges & institutions and the Indian context

The total of 32 participants represented over 12 organizations, including Faculty and student from India. Opening address for the symposium was delivered by Prof. Krishna Vedula, Executive Director of IUCEE along with Keynote Presentations by Prof. G. Raghurama, Vice Chancellor of DIT University, India, and Prof. Sandeep Inamdar, Vice President of Vishwaniketan, India. Apart from keynote addresses, a panel Discussion Session on "Challenges in the Implementation of Problem & Project Based Learning" (Dr. G. Vishnu Murthy, Dean, Anurag University, Dr. Venkatesh, Principal of Malnad CoE, Dr. B.K. Singh, Dean, DIT University) was delivered. Special Sessions on "Alternative PBL Models" by Dr. Vikas Shinde, Director of PBL Centre, Vishwaniketan, and Case Study on Synergsing P2BL & Design Thinking" by Dr. Deepak Waikar (Managing Partner, EduEnergy, Singapore) made the conference more interesting. More than 30 Case Studies were discussed on P2BL Practices by faculty members, curriculum designers, course managers, practitioners, and researchers from various Engineering Colleges and Institutions.

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
